



**ADMISSIONS INFORMATION**

The completed application, along with supporting documentation, should be submitted twenty (20) days before the beginning of the semester in which the applicant plans to enroll. Applications received after this will be processed at the discretion of the institution. Submission of false or misleading information relating to the application or academic record may lead to rejection or dismissal. Applicants will receive official notification of their acceptance by mail after they have been admitted both to the Graduate College and to a specific graduate degree program. Admission to the Graduate College is not to be interpreted as automatic admission into a specific degree program.

**ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS**

1. An undergraduate degree from a regionally accredited institution. (For some graduate degree programs specific undergraduate course work or majors are required.)
2. Required G.P.A. for regular or provisional admission\* is determined by the degree program.
3. Test scores:  
MAT - Regular admission: 395+ (44+); Provisional admission: 384 (27)  
GRE - Regular admission: 800+; Provisional admission: 700  
TOEFL Score (for international students whose native language is not English): 500+

\*Provisionally admitted students must satisfy requirements, earn no grade less than a B, and apply for regular admission immediately after 9 semester hours have been completed.
