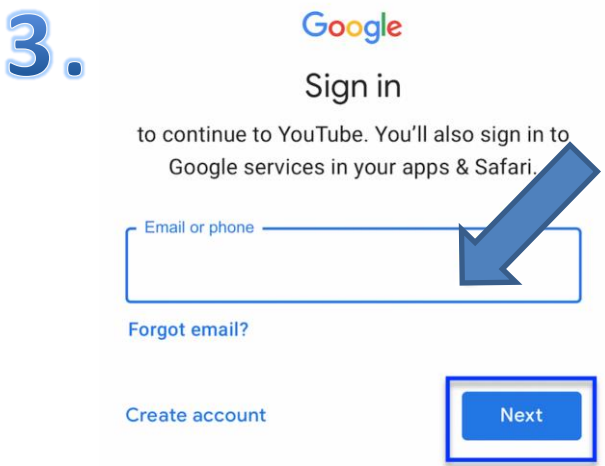


1. First you need to download the YouTube app from your device's app store (if you haven't already).

2. YouTube Icon -

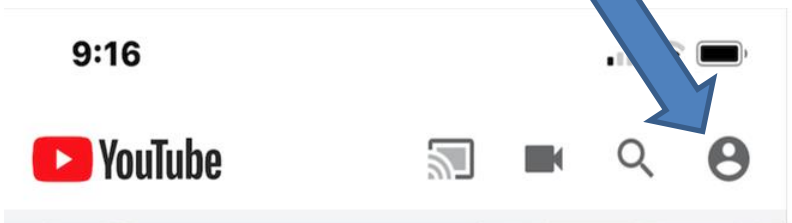


2. Next, from your Mobile Device, select the YouTube icon to launch the YouTube app.




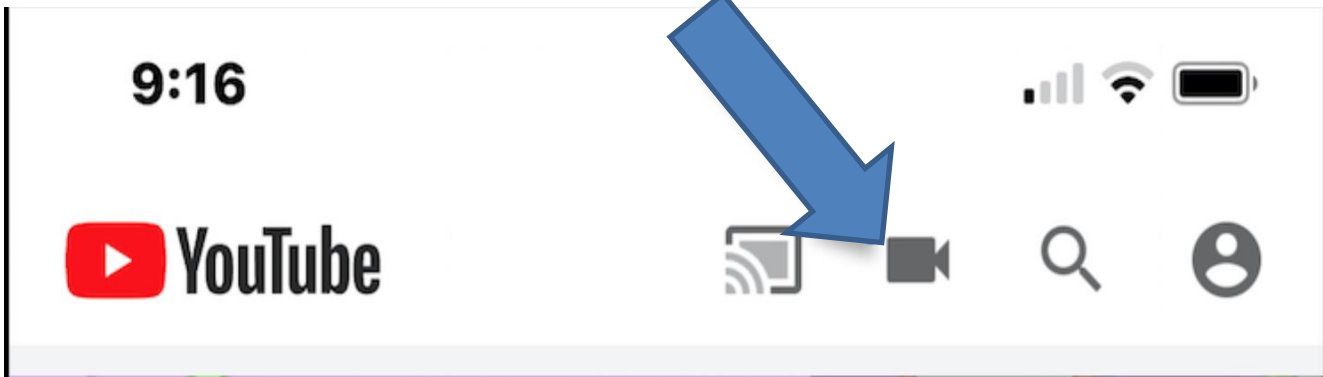
3. After launching the YouTube app, sign into your Google Account (Note that you can use your Gmail account username & password to sign into YouTube).

Also, if the Sign in option doesn't appear when you launch the app you can select the Profile icon  Located in the top right corner to launch the Sign in page.

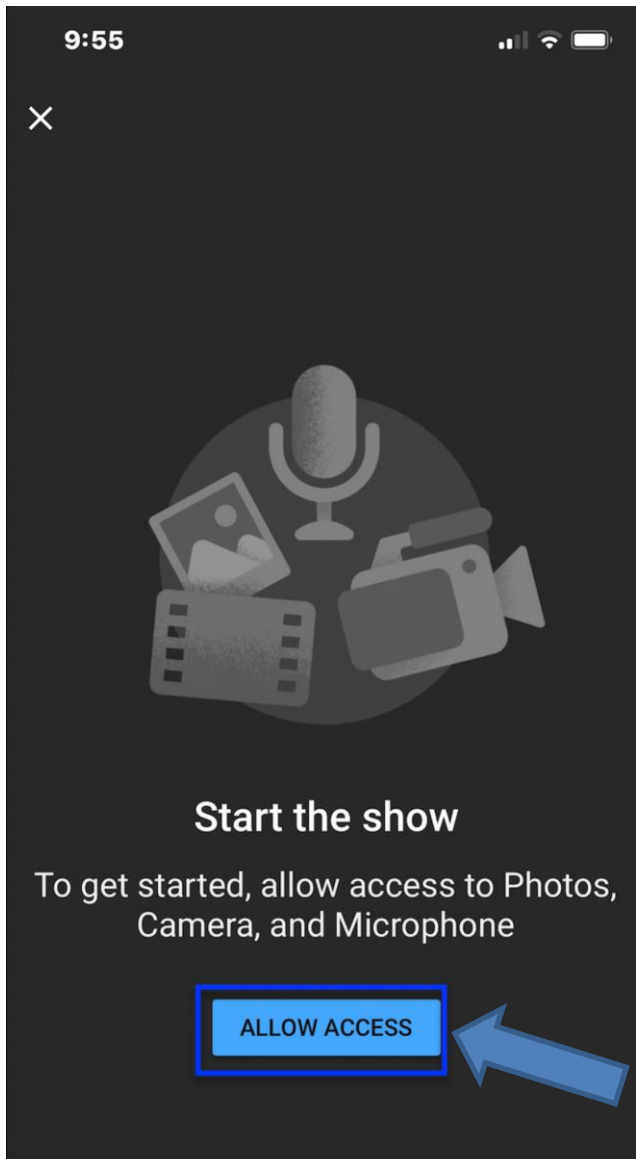

4. After signing in, select the video recorder icon  located at the top of your screen.

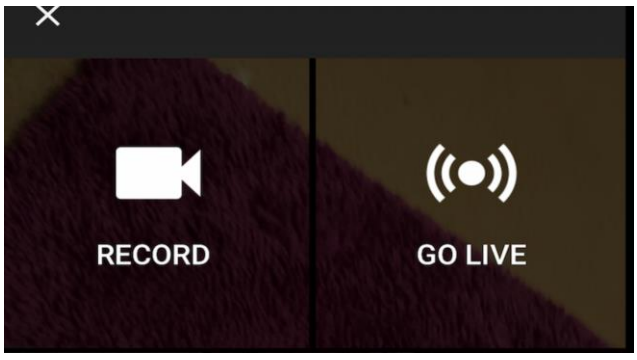

5. Next, click the blue **Allow Access** button as you will need to allow the app access to your microphone, camera and photos (therefore select **OK** when prompted).

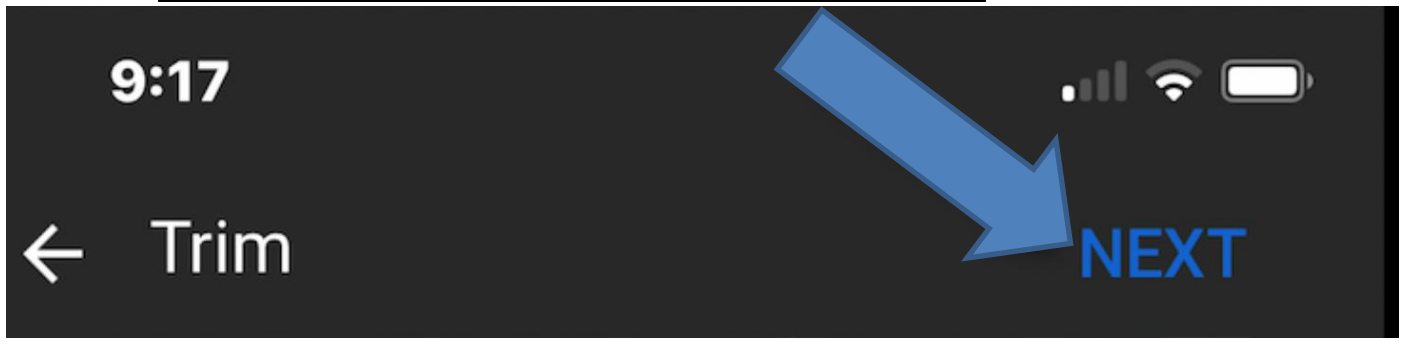

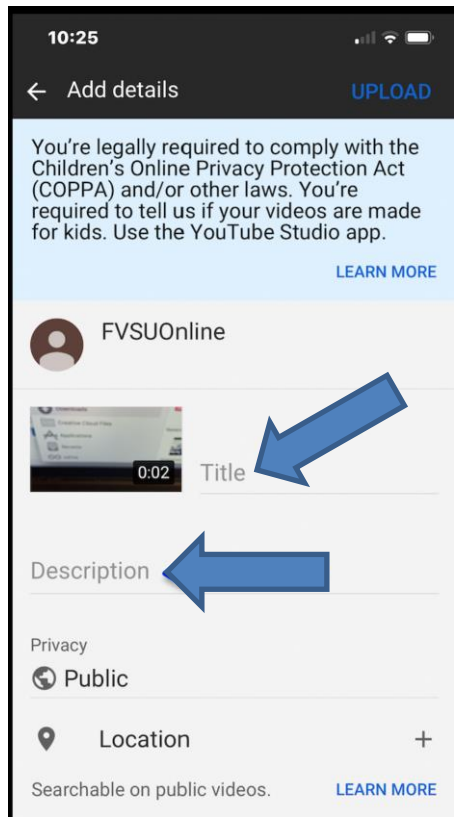
6. Once you have allowed access you can then record a video, live stream or choose a prerecorded video to upload (for example, selecting **RECORD** will begin the recording process).

7. After selecting your video, you will then be given the option to trim/edit the video. When you're done select **NEXT**.

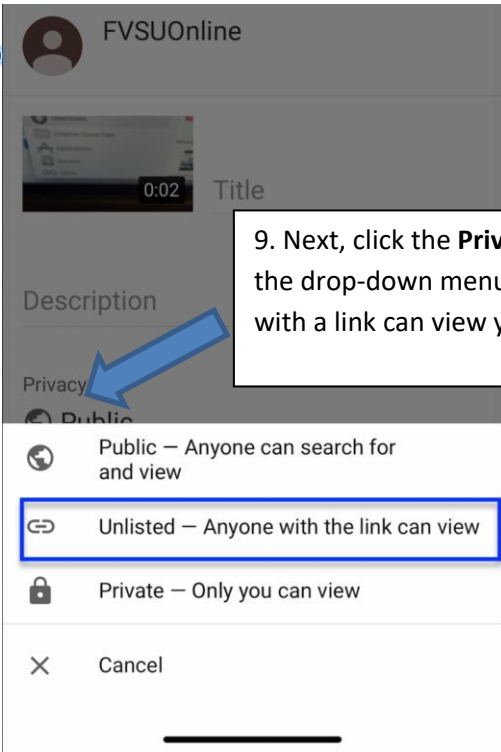

9. Next, click the **Privacy** tab and select **Unlisted** from the drop-down menu. This will ensure that only people with a link can view your video.
