#### Connect with peers

#### Get your passport!

Passport processing times can take up to a couple of months, do not waste time and apply for one. Visit Global Campus on our website to learn about the next Passport Caravan on campus.

#### Choose your program

Do you dream of a summer in Africa or would rather visit the art museums in Europe? Do you want to study or intern abroad? We will help you explore all of your options to find the program that is right for you.

## Apply for funding

There are thousands of study abroad scholarships out there. Most application processes will close 6-8 months before the summer programs. Make sure you meet the deadlines.

#### Attend Pre-Departure Orientation

During these sessions you will meet other FVSU students going abroad and learn everything you need to know before your trip: itinerary, accomodation, what cultural differences to expect, what to bring, etc.
