**Assessment Results**

1a. The unit did not meet the goal. The unit had a decrease in enrollment from fall of 2011 (64)to fall of 2012 (55).

1b.In the fall of 2012 the program enrolled 54 students.

**Use of Results**

1a. To increase effectiveness, the unit continued to use empowering strategies for the program to contribute to the growth in enrollment in the program.

1b. To improve enrollment, the program updated its informational brochure, continued to participate in the university Preview Days, ACM activities and high-school visitations.

3a. 12% of students from the 2006 cohort graduated by 2012 (within 6 yrs).

3b. 33% of students from the 2007 cohort graduated by 2012 (within 5 yrs).

3c. 6% of students from the 2008 cohort graduated by 2012 (within 4

yrs).

### **Use of Results**

To improve graduation rate, the program, in collaboration with the office of Institutional Research, launched an awareness workshop entitled "graduation analysis".
