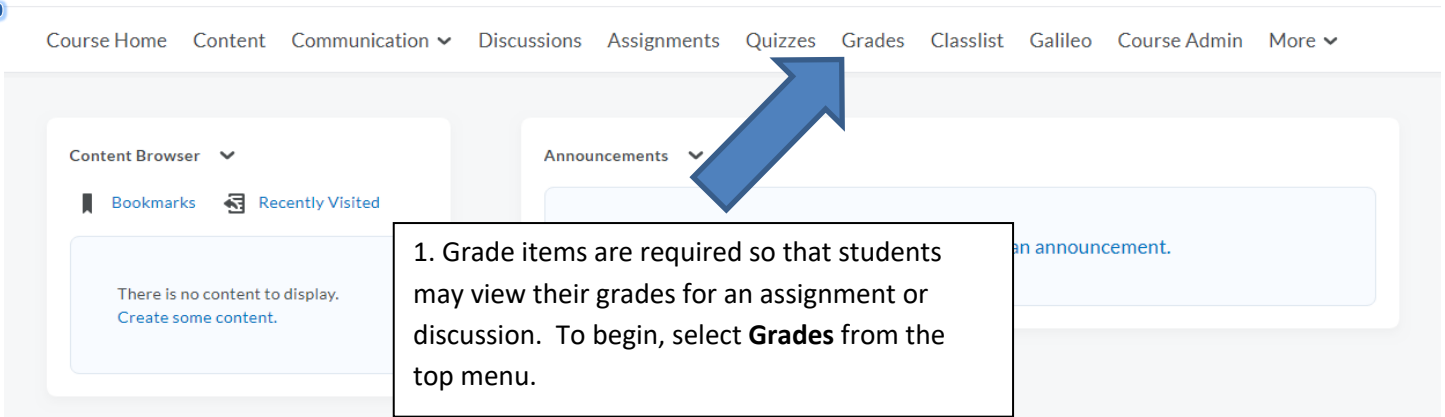

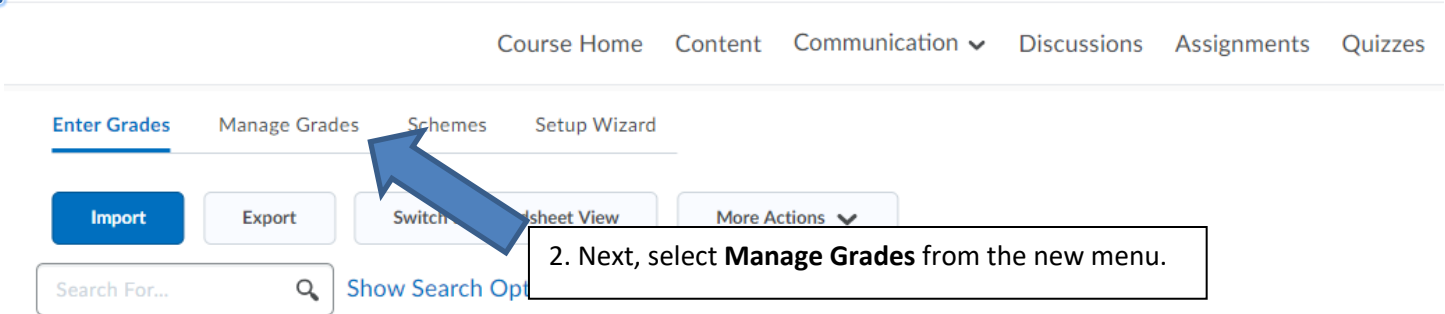

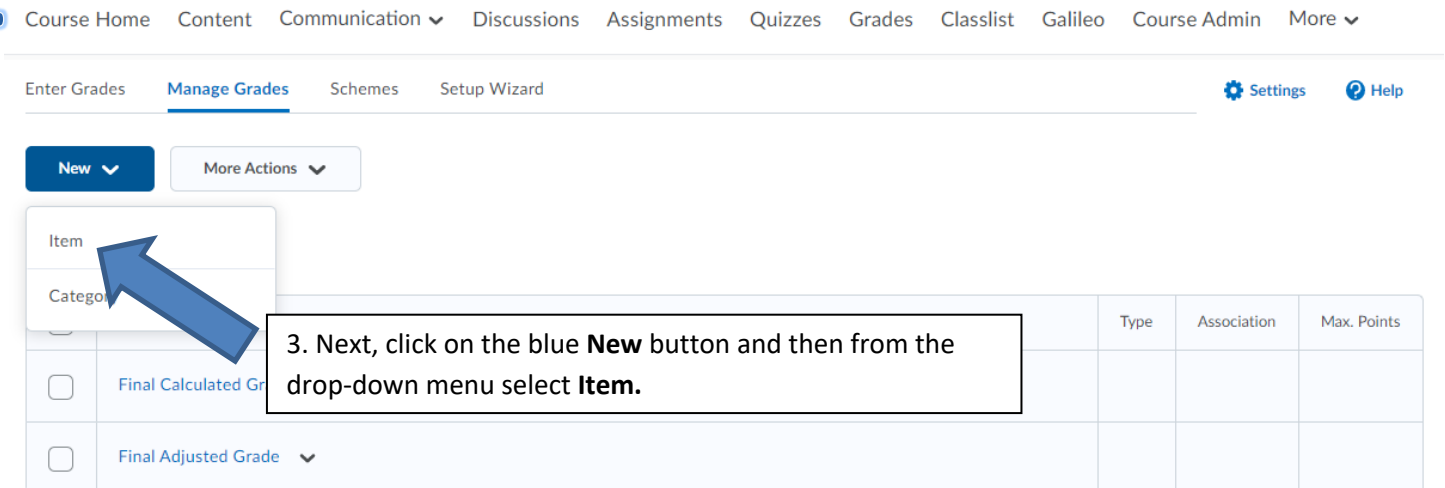

5. Finally, enter in a **Name** for the Grade item (It is suggested that the Grade Item and the assignment/discussion title share the same name. For example: if your assignment is titled "Assignment #10" then your Grade Item should be titled as "Assignment #10") and enter in the point value for the assignment/discussion (example: 10, 20, 100, etc.) under **Maximum Points**. Complete this process by pressing the blue **Save and Close** button.
