## 2020 Funding Opportunity Announcement



**Book Award**—Open to high school seniors and continuing college students who possess a strong desire for community and volunteer service and are currently attending an HBCU as a full-time student. Additional criteria applicants must have, do, or be:

- A graduating high school senior or currently enrolled college student (undergraduate or graduate) attending college in Fall 2020;
- A GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale;
- Applied and been admitted to Historically Black College or University (HBCU);
- Served the local Atlanta community via community service and/or volunteer hours for a community service organization serving the Atlanta metro area;
- Complete a narrative of no more than 250 words, discussing the following: “*What is the significance of an HBCU education in the 21st century?*”

Three (3) awards of \$500 each will be awarded. Applications will be accepted **September 1—September 30, 2020.**

### Review and Evaluation Process

Applications and supporting documents submitted to the Ivy & Roses Community Fund, Inc. are carefully reviewed by the Scholarship Committee to ensure criteria are met. Applicants will be notified upon receipt of submission. If additional information is required, a scholarship committee member will contact the applicant. No phone calls or deliveries please.
