Rapid Education Prototyping


Rapid Education Prototyping (REP4) is a learner-led approach for bringing long-term, equitable, paradigm-shifting change to higher education. Diverse learners, backed by an alliance of supporting organizations,

design new and better solutions for access, participation, and outcomes in public higher education. These collaborations, aligned for action, produce prototypes that can be rapidly expanded and put into action when they prove to be successful.

FVSU & THE NATIONAL EDUCATIONAL ALLIANCE'S OBJECTIVE IS TO ADDRESS EQUITY GAPS IN HIGHER LEARNING

The REP4 Alliance is a powerful network of regional and national education, industry, and technology leaders, led by eight higher education partners. The alliance works together to guide students (learners) along their transformative journeys, provide expertise, test prototypes, implement ideas, and shape the future of REP4.



Fort Valley State University, the Southeast founding partner and HBCU (Historically Black College or University) serving member, along with Grand Valley State University, REP4's organizer and convener, and founding Midwest partner; and six other founding partners, Amarillo College, a community college in Texas; Boise State University, a Research II university in Idaho; California State University San Marcos, an HSI (Hispanic-Serving Institution) and AANAPISI (Asian American and Native American Pacific Islander-Serving Institution) in California; Connecticut State Colleges and Universities, a system of 17 public colleges and universities; Illinois Institute of Technology, a technology-focused university in Chicago and Shippensburg University, part of the state system in Pennsylvania.

PROGRAM COMMITMENTS AND BENEFITS

FVSU commitments to REP4 regional programming

- Support and advance the visibility of REP4 across the State and the Southeast Region.
- Recruit, assemble, and steward a robust network of innovative high school districts and community-based, youth-focused nonprofit organizations as partners.
- Appoint a single REP4 point of contact and institutional leadership team members to engage the network of high school districts and community partners.
- Curate earnest input and feedback and share results across and beyond the national REP4 Alliance.
- Provide university resources and investments to ensure minimum cost to participants.
- Provide student benefits for participation, upon successful completion of the learner experience.

High school districts and community-based partners commitments

- Recruit, nominate, or enlist a cohort of rising high school students or college bound students from diverse backgrounds, with an emphasis on students from low-income households, family first for college, and other historically marginalized students.
- Sustain a cohort of 5 or more student participants annually.
- Identify a primary contact to act as the REP4 contact within your organization.
- In concert with the FVSU REP4 Leadership Team, guide the student group through the learner design summits.
- Participate in quarterly virtual check-in meetings called by the FVSU REP4 Team.

Student participation benefits

- Free on campus residency during the summit
- Admission application fee waiver and guaranteed admission upon successful completion of the experience
- Competition for scholarship for strongest participants
- Learn and practice Design Thinking and gain entrepreneurial skills
- Connect with peers, coaches, and professionals to support future and lifelong learning
- Engage in student capacity building for college and career opportunities
- Program participation is free
